Guidelines for teachers about oral questions.

Oral Q. 1 : Read the following passage carefully. (5 Marks)

Skill : Reading.

Objective: To assess the reading ability.

Instructions for the teacher:

The question aims at assessing the ability of the student to read with comprehension. Since this is an oral question, each student is to be dealt independently. If the number of students in the class is big, the oral assessment may be spread over 4-5 days.

Everything that is alive needs energy. All animals get the energy they need from food. Human body can do all kinds of wonderful things for us. Food is the fuel that helps to keep the body running.

Plants use sunlight to make their own food. Animals are not able to do that. Some animals eat plants. Some animals eat other animals as meat. Some eat both the plants and animals.

Since plants make their own food using sunlight, the sun's energy is found in plants. The sun's energy is very strong. It loses a lot of its strength by the time it goes into a plant.

When we eat plants, we get more of the sun's energy than when we eat animals. That's why it is good to eat fruits and vegetables. When an animal eats a plant, the energy is less strong.
