Guidelines for teachers about written questions.

(Total Marks 30)

NOTE : Wherever necessary, teacher can explain the meaning of questions to the students in their respective language of instruction.

Q. 1) Skill : Listening.

Objective : To assess the ability of listening skill of the students.

A) Listen carefully and tick (✓) the correct word. (2 Marks)

Suggestion: The teacher will read the word and student will tick (✓) the correct word from the given three words.

- a) Sea b) Near

Allotment of marks : One mark for each correct answer.

a) No response (0 Mark)

b) If tick correct words then (2 Marks)
give one mark each.

B) Listen carefully and write the word. (2 Marks)

Suggestion: The teacher will read the word and student will listen and write them properly.

- a) Water b) Classroom

Allotment of marks : One mark for correct answer.

a) No response (0 Mark)

b) If write correct words then (2 Marks)
give one mark each.

C) Listen the word carefully and write its rhyming word. (2 Marks)

Suggestion: The teacher will read the word and students will listen and write it's rhyming word.

- a) Hill b) Say

Allotment of marks : One mark for each correct answer.

a) No response (0 Mark)

b) If write correct rhyming words then give (2 Marks)
one mark each.

Q. 2) Skill : Speaking

Objective : To assess the ability of speaking skill of the student.

Allotment of marks : Each correct reply carries one mark.

Suggestion: Student should observe the picture and tick the correct related sentences.

b) Malhar caught a big golden fish in his net.

Allotment of marks : Each correctly tick sentence carries one mark.

D) Read the riddle carefully and write down the answer. (2 Marks)

Suggestion: Student should read the riddle carefully and write the correct answer of it.

Objective : To assess the ability of writing skill.

Suggestion: Student should read the sentence carefully and write them properly in given four lines.

Allotment of marks : Each properly written sentence carries one mark.

Suggestion: Students should change the first letter of the word and make new meaningful word.
