2. The processes of study shall be as detailed below

- 1) Study of the different units of different subjects and correspondence.
- 2) Completion of home assignments and other work.
- 3) Self-study with the help of the printed study library books and graded test papers.
- 4) Supervised practice Teaching and school organization.
- 5) Self-study with the help of the printed study library books and graded test papers.

3. Evaluation: (1) The assignments of each student will be evaluated centrally by the personnel specially appointed for the purpose viz. Evaluators and subject Specialist at the Institute of Education.

(2) The practical work of each student will be evaluated at the Consultation Centres by Guides.

(3) Practical lessons of each student will be evaluated by the Supervisors specially appointed for the purpose at the consultation centre.

4. The scheme should be administered centrally by the Institute of Education through the special unit to be set up at the said institute for implementation of the scheme. Consultation Centres to be located at suitable places like Colleges of Education, Colleges of Education, Secondary schools within a convenient distance from the place of work of the

5. Each pupil-teacher enrolled for training under this scheme should be charged normal fees of Rs.6/- p.m. for a period of 1 year as per the regular D.Ed. course plus Rs.4/- term fee plus Rs.5/- as Registration fee plus an amount of Rs.40/- (approx) for the supply of books and other instructional materials. The fees and the amount of Rs.40/- received from the candidate should be credited to Govt. receipt head "XXII-Education-D-Special-Fees and other Govt. Special Schools-(4) Training Schools" and the
