Preface

National Education Policy 2020 states that 'the ability to read and write and perform basic operations with numbers, is a necessary foundation and an indispensable prerequisite for all future schooling and lifelong learning'. Following this, center has published guidelines for implementation of 'National Initiative for Proficiency in reading with Understanding and Numeracy' – NIPUN Bharat which is a National Mission on Foundational Literacy and Numeracy. The vision of this mission is to create an enabling environment to ensure universal acquisition of foundational literacy and numeracy so that every child achieves the desired learning competencies in reading, writing and numeracy at the end of grade III. As the guidelines mention, learning gaps will be identified along with their probable reasons and various strategies keeping in view the local circumstances and diversity of country will be initiated.

The literacy engagement for (lower level/third language) English requires connectivity and linkage to what students know in their first language. The context of texts should not be culturally and socially alien to children because this will hamper the process of meaning-making. While developing these workbooks, due care is taken to follow these guidelines. The activities in the workbook are roughly based on the Balbharati text books and are developed keeping the Learning Outcomes of the Foundational Literacy and Numeracy in mind.

Primarily, the workbook is a (SLM) Self Learning Material and these activities are self-explanatory. Activity specific instructions are provided to the facilitators wherever learners may need the support.

Teachers/Facilitators are suggested to keep the track of a child's progress and monitor and support him/her. As the guidelines suggest, teacher should allow code-mixing and code-switching to children for expressing themselves. The activities in the workbooks can be conducted parallel to the use of ELCRLM (English Kit) provided by the state.

We hope that stakeholders across the state will find the workbooks engaging and useful for the students. Let's get ourselves on the mission mode and devote ourselves for the universal acquisition of foundational literacy and numeracy.

Role of Facilitators

Facilitators, Mentors and Teachers need to work hand in hand for the overall holistic development in a child. Community participation would be a central and overarching factor in planning, implementation, and monitoring the interventions of the FLN mission. The National Mission on FLN would work towards enhancing the participation of the community, parents, teachers, and children. All the facilitators including the teachers and the parents play vital roles in the lives of the students, especially in the foundational years. The time is now ripe in India to involve parents and community members as active stakeholders in children's education.

Parents who are ready to volunteer and take the benefit of their service for various activities of the school must be involved in a structured way.

- All the facilitators including the teachers need to build a warm, inclusive learning environment, mentor and nurture students.
- All the facilitators should motivate and facilitate in a manner that will make the students work independently wherever necessary on the activity sheets.
- Teachers should mentor the students with different levels of achievements so that students develop their language skills.
- Teachers as counselors counsel the students wherever needed so that activities are undertaken as decided in consultation with the parents and students.
- This book will allow teachers to introduce a variety of words with ideas for using them in writing and language to their students.
- Facilitators can move easily into a writing prompt, oral language development, and other dialogue for increasing and understanding the use of words.
- This book presents teachers with a guide to follow when integrating vocabulary words in speaking and writing.
- Each chapter of this book builds on the themes and word lists from the previous chapter to allow for continuous growth of learning for students.
- Facilitators other than marathi medium schools can translate instructions for their students.

Role of Students

Literacy begins at birth. Right from the start infants try to communicate with those around them through crying and cooing, smiling and babbling. As toddlers, they pay close attention to their caregivers, striving to imitate the sounds they hear, the gestures they see—all the while attempting to make sense of the world around them.

All young children from every culture, early literacy is a process of meaning-making.

For most of us, however, literacy means being able to read and write.

Today's research shows us how reading and writing can develop naturally in a continuum from infancy onward as young children make sense of their world through playful exploration.

It shows how children's brains take in this information, extracting their own rules from it to help them learn. It also shows how teachers and the other

adults around children can build on children's own ideas (scaffolding) to help them develop the skills necessary for reading and writing. Such research has changed our minds forever about the way children develop and how we can best support their growth.

We now know, for instance, that reading and writing are outgrowths of the same communication urge that drives children to express themselves orally. Thus, speaking and listening are also a part of early literacy.

- Students should actively participate in working on the activity sheets.
- Students should complete one worksheet before taking a new one.
- Students should solve the activity according to the specified timeline and repeat the activities.

Let's lay a strong foundation in language and literacy so that students develop competencies of reading, writing, and speaking necessary in the 21st century.

 Oral Language Development: Includes improved listening comprehension, oral vocabulary and extended conversation skills.



2) Reading Comprehension: Involves constructing meaning from a text and thinking critically about it.



3) Writing: Involves the ability to express themselves in writing in initial stages with their familiarity and understanding encoded sounds to write words.



 Vocabulary: Developing knowledge of a wide range of words and word meanings.



5) Phonological Awareness: Involves building an understanding of the sound structure of a language.



6) **Decoding:** Involves deciphering written words based on understanding the relationship between symbols and their sounds.



7) Reading Fluency: Refers to the ability to read a text with accuracy, speed (automaticity), expression (prosody) and comprehension that allows children to make meaning from the text.





8) Culture of Reading/Inclination towards Reading: Involves the motivation to engage with a wide variety of books and other reading materials.


