Guidelines for teachers about oral questions. (Total Marks 10)

Oral Q. 1: Read the following passage carefully. (5 Marks)

Skill : Reading

Objective: To assess the reading ability.

Instructions for the teacher:

The question aims at assessing the ability of the student to read with comprehension. Since this is an oral question, each student is to be dealt in independently. If the number of students in the class is big, the oral assessment may be spread over 4-5 days.

I was walking along the footpath with my friends when we came to a signal crossing. The lights were green and heavy traffic was just whizzing past us. Suddenly I saw a blind old man trying to cross the street. I rushed to his aid and holding his hand explained about the green signal. When the signal turned to red, heavy vehicles stopped, but few cyclists paid no heed to the signal and rode past almost throwing the poor man down. I raised the man held him steadily and crossed the road with him.
