Government is pleased to sanction the establishment of a State Institute of Education for improvement of Primary Education in the State. The Institute should be located in the Government Basic Training College for Men, Poona and should be entrusted with the following functions:-

- 1) To give for inservice training to all inspecting officers (dealing primary schools) and the staff of training institutions for primary teachers in such a manner that every officer will undergo a total term of about three months in every five years of service;
- 2) To conduct studies and investigations in the training of primary teachers in problems of primary education in general and in the teaching of the basic school subjects at the primary stage in particular;
- 3) To provide an extension service to all training institutions for primary teachers in the State;
- 4) To provide literature (inclusive of teaching aids) for primary school teachers;
- 5) To provide an orientation training to the staff of training institutions, primary teachers and inspecting officers of primary schools when they enter upon their career; and
- 6) To coordinate the work of the Extension Service Centres in training institutions for primary teachers. The Institute should start functioning with effect from 1st June 1964. The Director of Education should be requested to take all preliminary steps necessary to get the Institute functioning from the stipulated date.

2. Sanction is also accorded to the creation of the following Gazetted and Ministerial posts for the proposed Institute for a period upto 28th February 1965 in the first instance:-

The Director of Education should be asked to incur an expenditure not exceeding Rs.30,000/- on pay allowances of the staff immediately required to be recruited to Institute and other contingent expenditure. The Director of Education should further be requested to submit the necessary proposals filing in the post of Principal and Vice Principal immediately.

4. The expenditure of Rs.30,000/- on the establishment of the State Institute of Education during the current year should initially be met from the State Funds and debited to the "28-Edn-D-Spl. 1-1 Trg. Schools" and full reimbursement thereof should be obtained from the Government of India towards the end of financial year. The Director of Education should be requested to forward the necessary expenditure statements of the Institute to the Government of India, the Accountant General, Bombay and Government by 15th March 1964 in order to enable the Accountant General to make the necessary adjustments in due time.
